CHECK-IN DATE:

Participant Check-In: Tuesday, July 7th 9:00am CST - 2:00pm CST

Boxers or their Coach must present their USA Boxing passbook with a **current member ID card** showing their birth date verification and current athlete physical certification to receive their event credential. Online check-in will be available starting Sunday, July 5th, 2026.

BOXER ONLINE REGISTRATION:

The National Junior & Youth Golden Gloves is an open registration tournament to all current members of USA Boxing and international participants. There will be both Open (10 bouts or more) and Novice (9 bouts or less) contested brackets.

Bout experience is determined by a boxer's matchtracker history. If you have documented bouts in the boxer's passbook that are missing online, you must fill out the **USA BOXING MISSING MATCHTRACKER BOUTS** form. If you have LEGACY bouts or non-USA Boxing amateur combative sports experience, contact USA Boxing Membership Services 719-866-2300.

REQUESTS FOR EXCEPTIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

All participants (Boxers, Coaches, & Officials) must register online through WEBPOINT.

Boxers must have Birth Date Verification & Athlete Physical Certification completed ***before*** they will be allowed to register for the event.

WEIGH-INS AND PHYSICALS:

Trial Scales will be available Tuesday July 7th from 9:00am-5:00pm and Wednesday July 8th-Saturday July 11th at 6:00am at the Allen Events Center.

Weigh-ins will be held at Allen Events Center at 7:00 AM each day. Physicals will take place immediately following the Boxer's weigh-in. Boxer's only weigh-in on the day they box. **NO WEIGHT ALLOWANCE!!**

COMPETITION SESSIONS:

One session daily Wednesday July 8th through Saturday July 11th starting at 12:00 Noon.

EQUIPMENT:

Competition gloves will be provided at the National Tournament and must be used by all boxers in the competition. Headgear **will not** be provided.

***All Junior & Youth open class boxers will be required to wear open-faced headgear.*

UNIFORMS:

Boxers are allowed to wear uniforms of any color they choose as long as they are not in conflict with the USA Boxing Rulebook. See Appendix E - Boxers' Uniform Guidelines for more information.

TOURNAMENT DRAW:

The tournament draw will take place at Allen Events Center on Tuesday July 7th immediately following the technical meeting.

WALKOVERS & AWARDS:

If a boxer is present and his/her opponent is a "no show" without at least 3 hours' notice to OIC, the boxer who attended will receive a "win" and the boxer who is not present will receive a "loss".

Boxers will only be awarded if they have competed at least once in a tournament bout. He or she must weigh-in and can only be awarded the championship title if they win in the ring or if their scheduled opponent has pulled out. Only in that case can a boxer win the championship by walkover.

OFFICIALS ELIGIBILITY:

All registered and duly certified officials are eligible to work the tournament regardless of level. Level 1 certified officials will be eligible to work as a Judge only.

*ALL officials wishing to work the tournament, **MUST ATTEND** the Pre-Tournament seminar on Tuesday July 7th at 2:00 PM CST. Officials arriving after that time must contact Tournament OIC, Rick How 816-830-9947.*

► All Officials must register online through WEBPOINT.

All officials must present their USA Boxing passbook with a current member ID card showing their current officials certification and current safesport training to receive their event credential.

****First 40 Officials to register will receive free lodging for the tournament duration.***

OFFICIALS ATTIRE:
